Note: All candles here are imitation. Real candles will burn the paper which will start a fire.

F. Vases, Candles, Streamers

Large Vase

Supplies

Peaceful Place Specialty DSP #156394
Gray Granite Shimmer Ribbon #152463

Instructions

Cut Peaceful Place (Silver trees on White) in half. Score 1" in on one piece of DSP. Rotate one piece so all trees are standing upright. Put Tear & Tape on Underside of one edge and on top of the edge of the. Other piece of paper. Overlap the two pieces of DSP by 1, remove protective layer over Tear & Tape and press to seal. Do the same for 4" pieces of gray buffalo checked paper. Then overlap the tree paper with the buffalo check after putting Tear & Tape along edges. Seal. Lay down a strip of Tear & Tape along seam



Smaller Vase 1

Supplies

Peaceful Place Specialty DSP #156394

Instructions

Trim paper width to height of vase. Place Tear & Tape along edges of paper. Wrap paper around vase overlapping edges. Make sure edges are straight. Press to seal.



Smaller Vases 2 & 3

Supplies

Painted Christmas DSP #156292
Heartwarming Hugs DSP #153492
Real Red Mini Ruffled Ribbon #156323

Instructions

Trim paper width to height of vase. Place Tear & Tape along edges of paper. Wrap paper around vase overlapping edges. Make sure edges are straight. Press to seal. Wrap ribbon around top of vases. Keep them in place with Tear & Tape or Glue Dots. Embellish with triple bows kept on with glue dots.



Smallest Vase

Place Wonderful Snowflakes #156340 randomly around outside of glass adhering with glue dots.

Holiday Helper 2021: Festive Tables Pine Boughs Candle



Tree Candle

Supplies

Silver Foil Specialty Paper #156457
Evergreen Border Punch #153603
Smokey Slate Textured Ribbon #155813
Simply Elegant Trim #155766

Instructions

Use the border punch to punch a series of tree outlines into a piece of silver foil. Measure around the candle. Cut ribbon to that measurement + 1". Run a strip of Tear & Tap through the middle of the ribbon. Drape ribbon around candle making sure edges line up. Remove protective tape and press. Drape trees around candle slightly overlapping the gray ribbon. Adhere foil with glue dots. Embellish by wrapping silver trim around gray ribbon several times topping off with a multiple looped bow adhered with a glue dot.



Another large vase wrapped with Painted Christmas DSP #156292 And Real Red Mini Ruffled Ribbon #156323

Supplies

Brushed Metallic cardstock #152534
Garden Green cardstock #102584
Old Olive / Pretty Peacock Reversible Ribbon #149496
Christmas Pinecone #156309

Instructions

Line cardstock with adhesive sheets. Use pinecone bough dies to create boughs: two in Garden Green; the other two in the darker Brushed Metallic paper. Remove protective paper from adhesive. Place green over gold and press to adhere. Press boughs onto candle, use glue dots in addition if needed. Embellish by tying ribbon around the top & bottom of candle.



Holly Candle

Supplies

Silver Foil Specialty Paper #156457
Holly Border Punch #156379

Instructions

Use the border punch to punch out an outline of holly in a 2" strip of silver foil. Put a strip of Tear & Tape on the edge of the foil where it will overlap on the candle. Wrap foil around the candle after removing protective paper from tape. Press the 2 edges together to seal. So easy! So pretty when the light shines through!



Streamers / Garlands

My daughter-in-law loves to hang these from the dining room light fixtures. I hung these from tied together plastic branches. My grands tape them onto their windows...

Supplies

Punches or dies to make small any small decorative pieces. I used:

Instructions

Line cardstock with adhesive sheets. Use pinecone bough dies to create boughs: two in Garden Green; the other two in the darker Brushed Metallic paper. Remove protective paper from adhesive. Place green over gold and press to adhere. Press boughs onto candle, use glue dots in addition if needed. Embellish by tying ribbon around the top & bottom of candle.

Cozily Wrapped Candles

Supplies

Deer Builder Punch #156390

Stitched Snowflake Dies #156455

Basic Borders Dies #155558

Heartwarming Hugs DSP #153492

Peaceful Prints #156628

Red Velvet Paper #153490

Snowy White Velvet Sheets #156405

Instructions

Use the Deer Builder punch to punch out about 7 deer from DSP. Measure candle height and cut gingham green paper so that it doesn't completely cover the candle about 5" x 12". Glue a strip of red DSP in the middle of the gingham about 2 3/4" x 12", then a strip of white about 1 3/4" x 12. After gluing, put Tear & Tape on overlapping edges. wrap paper around candle. Press to seal after removing protective paper. Adhere punched out deer to middle white layer.

For the other candle die cut out stitched out snowflakes from the white and red velvet snowflakes (about 9 white and 7 red). Layer some red ones on top of the white & adhere with glue dots and liquid glue. Use border dies to cut out a 2 1/2" x 12" band of red velvet. (I used the zig zag die.) Glue red velvet band around the DSP. Adhere snowflakes to red velvet band all the way around the candle.



Snowflake Garlands Mirror Image Garlands

Supplies

Stitched Snowflake Dies #156455
So Many Snowflakes Dies #153560
Basic White ##159276
Brushed Metallic Cardstock #153524
White Glittered Organdy Ribbon #156408

Notes & Instructions

Basically, die cut a bunch of snowflakes keeping like ones with like. Then adhere a snowflake to the organdy ribbon with 2 mini glue dots. Then take the matching snowflake, line it up the same way the 1st one is lined up and adhere it to the other side of the organdy ribbon. Repeat until you have a number of snowflakes on the ribbon and it is the desired length.



Deer Garlands Reverse Image Garlands

Supplies

Deer Builder Punch #156390
Heartwarming Hugs (green gingham) DSP #153492
Peaceful Prints (mini black & red buffalo check) DSP #156628
Baker's Twine Essentials Pack #155475

Notes & Instructions

Punch out a bunch of deer from the front of the DSP. Then cut as many out from the back of the DSP. This will create a mirror image of the die cut. Turn the 2nd die cut over. Attach the deer die cut to the Baker's twine with a glue dot making sure the deer is oriented upright. If you attach the deer at the wrong point it could look like it is prancing upside down, etc. (Somewhere in the throat worked best for me.) Then align the second deer so that it matches the first. The same pattern paper should be facing out. Glue both together with liquid glue. Repeat further down the twine until garland is desired length.

Poinsettia Garlands Separated Image Garlands

Supplies

Merriest Moments Bundle #156783
Layering Circles Dies #151770
Basic White card stock #159276
Soft Seafoam card stock #146988
Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace Trim #149693
Holiday Rhinestones #150457 or
Rhinestone Basic Jewels #144220 (colored with alcohol markers)

Notes & Instructions

Use dies to cut out large sets and small sets of the poinsettia flowers. Cut out one of each from a little larger piece of card stock giving a good amount of space between each one. Set up the Stamparatus for multiple stamping of die cuts. Take the larger piece of card stock from which we cut a large and small set of petals and tape it onto a piece of graph paper for the Stamparatus. Use magnets or tape to keep paper where it was originally on the Stamparatus platform. Now take the flower stamps and fit them into the card stock where the dies were cut out stamps face down. Then carefully press plate onto stamps so they stick to the plate. Lift. Fit one of the die cuts into the empty spaces made in the cut-out cardstock. The die cuts will fit like puzzle pieces as you continue. Ink the stamps and close the plate so that the stamp presses into the die cut. Lift plate remove die cut. Check to see the image is centered in the middle of the die cut. The stamp position may have to be adjusted within the cut out. Repeat positioning of die cut within cut out, ink and stamp. When you have enough flower die cuts, curl leaves up slightly with a bone folder. Adhere little one to top of big flower with a dimensional. Embellish with a rhinestone in the middle of the flower. Now we'll not be able to place the images back-to-back because they are not symmetrical images. So take the smallest circle and cut out 1 circle for every two sets of flowers in soft seafoam. Adhere one flower on one side of the lace trim with large glue dots. Repeat until all flowers are used up and garland is desired length.
